

DESIGN NOTICE KAINS STREET CONSTRUCTION – MONDAMIN STREET TO ALMA STREET

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The City of St. Thomas is excited to announce that we are starting the design of Kains Street from Mondamin Street to Alma Street.

Project scope will include replacement of sewers and watermain from Mondamin Street to St. Catherine Street as well as road, and sidewalk replacements throughout the whole project. A new roundabout will also be constructed at the intersection of Kains Street and St. Catherines Street. Construction is expected to take place in 2024 subject to council approval.

The proposed design uses a Complete Streets approach to improve and enhance accessibility for all road users including transit, vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians of all ages and abilities. The design will create space for a grass boulevard and a new multi use trail from the Scott Street Parking lot to the existing trail just west of John Street. Bike lanes will also be implemented on the north and south side of the road from John Street. to Alma Street.

A Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held before construction begins to give you an opportunity to see proposed plans and speak to City staff about the project. More information about the PIC will be communicated in early 2024.
