CITY OF ST. THOMAS

BY-LAW NO. 35 -2022

A by-law to amend By-Law No. 84-2017, being a by-law to establish a Basement Flooding Subsidy Program in the City of St. Thomas.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the "Eligible Work" section of Schedule "A" be deleted and replaced with the following:

Eligible WorkFunding will be based on amounts as shown in the table below:

Disconnection of foundation drains and installation of new	City to administer program for installation of sump pump.	City to reimburse 90% of costs, up to a maximum of

Installation of backwater valve on sanitary drain connection *	City to administer program for installation of sump pump. Residents to contact City and sign up for program, with City paying 50% of installation cost (based on 2 contractor quotes obtained by homeowner)	City to reimburse 50% of costs, up to a maximum of \$750
Building/Plumbing Permit Fee	The City will pay for the cost of the building/plumbing permit for the installation of a sump pump or the installation of a backwater valve or a combination of both options through the City-Wide Basement Flooding Program budget	City to cover 100% of the permit fee through the program

- (*) Eligibility for funding requires that the homes Foundation Drains have an appropriate outlet, other than the sanitary sewer, in accordance with the *Property Standards By-law*; If Foundation Drains do not exist, or are not connected to the sanitary main drain or Building Sewer, the licensed plumber/drainage contractor must verify this in writing based on a camera/video inspection.
 - 2. That Appendix "B" be deleted and Schedule "A" to this by-law be put in its place.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The property must not have exceeded the life-time maximum grant amount for each eligible installation.
- 2. To be eligible for the grant:
 - You must be the registered owner of a single-family residential, duplex or triplex property
 within the City of St. Thomas. NOTE: Multi-family dwelling units are not eligible for grants
 related to backwater valves, as their installation is restricted by the Ontario Building Code.
 - The grant is available only to existing homes, not homes in the planning stages or currently under construction.
 - The downspouts from your property's eavestrough must be disconnected from the sewer system.
 - If the property has a paved front yard parking area. It must comply with the City's Zoning Bylaw requirements.
 - You must submit your application within six months of completion of work as indicated on your invoice.
 - A permit must be obtained, and inspection passed by a City of St. Thomas building inspector for a backwater valve, sump pump installation and disconnection of foundation drain.
 - Original invoices must be provided
 - Backwater valve only: You must demonstrate that your homes foundation drains have an appropriate outlet, if foundation drains do not exist or are not connected to the sanitary sewer, your contractor must verify this.
 - You must not have outstanding taxes or debts owed to the City of St. Thomas at the time your application is processed.

Acceptance of Grant Terms and Conditions

In applying for the Grant Program, I understand and agree to the following conditions:

- I am solely responsible for the work being done on my property.
- The City assumes no liability whatsoever relating to the work undertaken to be eligible for the grant, and the work cannot be considered a guarantee that flooding will not occur.
- The City of St. Thomas does not:
 - endorse specific brands, products, dealers, or contractors.
 - guarantee materials, workmanship, or performance of the eligible protective devices.
- I will not make any claim or take any action against the City of St. Thomas for losses, damages, expenses or costs of any nature whatsoever arising out of or related to my participation in the program, and indemnify the City against any such claim or action made or taken by someone else.
- If any incorrect or deceptive information, statement or representation is found in this application or the accompanying documents, the City is entitled to:
 - reject my application,
 - demand full and immediate repayment of any subsidy money paid to me.
 - prosecute me or take other legal action against me.
