Tree Lighting Celebration - DDB - November 16, 2018

K. English asked about the code for the public washrooms at City Hall.

THAT: An application be submitted to Southwestern Public Health for the food at the event; and further,

THAT: 4 picnic tables and 2 garbage cans be delivered by the Parks, Recreation and Propoerty Management Department for the event; and further,

THAT: The St. Thomas Fire Department transport Santa Claus to/from the event via City Fire Truck, with the understanding that an alternative method of transportation needs to be arranged should the truck have to respond to an emergency; and further,

THAT: The Parks, Recreation and Property Management Department provide access to the electrical source for entertainment and the tree lighting and arrange for the public washrooms to be available for use; and further,

THAT: All other necessary requirements be fulfilled to the satisfaction of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas.

THAT: All other necessary requirements be fulfilled to the satisfaction of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas.

Arrangements be made with the Parks and Recreation Department regarding hydro requirements and light access UNKNOWN

An Electrical Safety Authority permit be obtained and a copy provided to the Parks and Recreation Department UNKNOWN
