2020 Budget - Councillor Peters told the committee that Council has approved the 2020 Budget for \$3,000.

Special Events - S. Rodaway and C. Topping attended the Special Events committee meeting.

- Coldest Night of the Year event does not require parking and there were accessibility issues of concern.
- St. Thomas-Elgin Children's Water Festival– members have requested enough parking and accessible washrooms to be provided.
- Arrangements are being made at AirFest2020 (southwestern Ontario Wings and Wheels Association) to allow for accessible parking at the event.

<u>Site Plan Control</u> – C. Topping visited the 3 storey walk-ups on East street and reported concerns with parking. Councillor Peters explained that because this is on the North side of Talbot Street, parking is not required as per zoning by-laws. C. Topping then requested that the existing zoning area for loading/unloading be used as an accessible pick-up and drop-off location if possible. She will report back on to the committee on this suggestion.

C. Topping and Councillor Peters shared site plan information on the day care centre being constructed on St. Catharines St., specifically regarding the entrance and exit challenges. Van parking will be located closer to the entrance. There will be a horseshoe lane extending behind the building where drivers will enter on the South side and exit on the North side. The committee discussed concerns that if upgrades happen to the upper St. Catharines parking lot, handicapped parking spaces for the tourism office should be created.
