The Committee of Adjustment of the City of St. Thomas will hold a Public Hearing on the **12th day of November**, **2020** at **10:00 a.m.** by teleconference to consider this application.

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made by the owner, **FRANK SHERIFI**, for a minor variance pursuant to Section 45(1) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, on lands municipally known as **83 ALEXANDRIA AVENUE** in the City of St. Thomas, Ontario:

The subject lands are within the Third Residential Zone (R3) pursuant to the City of St. Thomas Zoning By-Law No. 50-88, as amended. The applicants are requesting the following variance:

 (i) To permit a covered porch to project 1.5m into a required front yard, whereas the Zoning By-law permits an uncovered porch to project a maximum of 1.5m into a required front yard. (Subsection 4.2.2 -PROJECTIONS INTO YARDS INTO RESIDENTIAL ZONES).

The applicant is in the process of constructing a triplex dwelling on the subject lands. A minor variance is required to permit an unenclosed, covered porch to project 1.5m into a required front yard, whereas the Zoning By-law only permits an uncovered porch to project a maximum of 1.5m into a required front yard.
