

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT**  
**APPLICATION NO. B11/20**  
**Plan 80, Blk 10, Lot 1-4**

Municipally known as **354 WELLINGTON STREET** in the **CITY OF ST. THOMAS**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Committee of Adjustment will hold a Public Meeting on the **14th day of January, 2021** at 10:00 a.m. by teleconference to consider an application that has been made by **WALTER OSTOJIC & SONS AND NOVI CONSTRUCTION LIMITED** for a consent pursuant to Section 53 of the Planning Act, 1990 as amended, for lands municipally known as **354 WELLINGTON STREET** legally described as **Plan 80, Blk 10, Lot 1-4** in the **CITY OF ST. THOMAS**, as shown on the Key Map below.

The subject lands are within the Third Residential Zone (R3) pursuant to the City of St. Thomas Zoning By-Law No. 50-88, as amended.

The applicant is proposing to sever a lot (Part 1) with frontage of 28.45m on Wellington Street and an area of 1,268.3sqm, containing one house and one detached garage. It is proposed that the lot will continue to be used for residential purposes. The applicant is proposing to retain a vacant lot (Part 2) with frontage of 12.36m on Wellington Street and an area of 550.3sqm. It is proposed that the lot will be developed with one single detached residential dwelling.

Three consent applications have been filed concurrently (B10/20, B11/20 and B12/20) for the purpose of creating five lots, including one lot containing the existing single detached residential dwelling and detached garage and four vacant building lots proposed to be developed with four single detached residential dwellings.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submission to the Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
