Municipally known as **2 CURRAH ROAD** in the **CITY OF ST. THOMAS**

TAKE NOTICE that the Committee of Adjustment will hold a Public Meeting on the **8th day of April, 2021** at 10:00 a.m. by teleconference to consider an application that has been made by **J. R. ROBERTSON HOLDING** for a consent pursuant to Section 53 of the Planning Act, 1990 as amended, for lands municipally known as **2 CURRAH ROAD** legally described as **PLAN 287, LOT 10** in the **CITY OF ST. THOMAS**, as shown on the Key Map below.

The subject lands are within the Employment Lands Zone (EL) pursuant to the City of St. Thomas Zoning By-Law No. 50-88, as amended.

The applicant is proposing to sever a vacant lot with frontage of 35.4m on Currah Road and an area of 3,217.1m², proposed to be used for future employment lands development purposes. The applicant is proposing to retain a lot with frontage of 45.7m on Currah Road and area of 4,142.8m², containing one building, proposed to continue to be used for employment lands purposes.

Consent application B03/21 has been filed for the purpose of creating one vacant lot for future employment lands development purposes.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submission to the Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
