Stage 2: The watermain testing has come back and has passed. Watermain connection to the existing watermain will be scheduled this week. To do these connections the existing watermain will need to be isolated and will result in water shut offs to some buildings. Advance notice of these shut offs will be given. Water service connections to each building will also be occurring. This connection can be done individually and can be scheduled with enough notice given. ### Road Closures and Access:

- Stage 2: Talbot St. from City Hall to Ross Street is now closed to through traffic, please follow the posted detour. On street parking within the construction zone is **not** permitted
- Stage 1: Talbot St. from Mary St to Mondamin St. is now reopened to through traffic, on street parking will resume were possible, construction activity and parking layby closures will be done as required to finish Stage 1.
- Front Door access may be interrupted periodically during construction, advance notification will be provided prior to any disruption
