### Work Scheduled for next week: (Stage 1 only Mary St. to City Hall)

- Watermain on White Street to be installed.
- Remaining Water services to each building
- Watermain chlorination and testing.
- Street light Electrical duct installation will continue working east from Hiawatha.

### Work completed so far: (Stage 1 only Mary St. to City Hall)

- Started electrical removals
- Installed new roadway catch basins
- Started installing new lighting duct work
- All of stage 1 Sanitary drain connections are now completed

- Talbot St. from Mary St to Princess Ave. will be closed to through traffic, please follow the posted detour.
- On street parking within the construction zone is **not** permitted
- Front Door access may be interrupted periodically during construction, advance notification will be provided prior to any disruption
