Coyne Street and Simcoe Construction





Construction is about to begin on the Coyne Street and Simcoe Street Construction project! **Work will start on Monday, April 17, 2023.** The contractor is Cassidy Construction Limited. Detailed information about the project is available at <u>stthomas.ca/coyneandsimcoe</u>.

Work completed to date:

- Locates of existing infrastructure
- Tree removal and trimming
- Traffic signage has been installed

Work scheduled for the next week:

- Begin Phase 1 construction of Simcoe Street from Churchill Crescent to First Avenue. The roadway will be closed to through traffic, but open to local traffic
- Begin setting up temporary watermain (Phase 1)
- Remove the roadway asphalt and curb in Phase 1

Road Closures and Access:

- Local traffic on Simcoe Street will be permitted
- Churchill Crescent will remain open.
- Short duration closure as needed will occur in a few weeks with advance notice provided. Access to Simcoe Street from First Avenue will be available.
- Driveway access may be interrupted periodically during construction. Notification will be provided in advance of a driveway access disruption
