The City of St. Thomas is finalizing the design of the Kain Street Construction project for construction in 2024. The work includes replacement of sanitary sewers, watermain, roadwork and sidewalks along Kain Street from Mondamin to Alma Street. The design also includes traffic calming measures, pedestrian crossings, bike lanes and a roundabout at St. Catharine Street. The Kains Street Construction project implements the City of St. Thomas "Complete Streets" philosophy by enhancing accessibility for all road users including vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians of all ages and abilities. In conjunction with the work on Kains Street, the City plans to convert both Curtis Street and Scott Street to two way traffic.
