Dear Property Owner/Occupant,

The City of St. Thomas will soon be starting construction on your street. This letter provides details about the project and important information on how construction may impact you.

Project Details

Location: Laura Avenue

Schedule: Tentative start date – week of July 1, 2019
Estimated time of completion – beginning of August 2019

Scope:

- Full replacement of pavement structure;
- Replacement of curbs;
- Replacement of street light poles;
- Topsoil and sod;
- Catchbasin lid replacement.

Contractor: Dufferin Construction

How will Construction Impact You?

Traffic: The roadway will be closed to through traffic during construction, but will remain open to local traffic at all times. Due to the nature of this work, there will be times during the project when driveway access will be limited or restricted for a short period of time. Advance notice of driveway impacts will be provided when possible.

Parking: On street parking will be permitted outside of construction work hours. Work hours are anticipated to be 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Vibration: Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

Garbage/Recycling Collection: Access for garbage/recycling collection will be maintained when possible. In the event there is a disruption, the contractor will pick up your garbage (where you usually leave it) and move it to a location it can be picked up at. Please mark your municipal address on all containers.

Private Sprinkler Systems, Landscaping or Fencing: Please remove all items on City property in advance of construction. The City is not responsible for damage to items located on City property.

Safety: Stay safe and avoid the work area during construction. Maintain a safe distance from construction vehicles entering and leaving the site.
