

## 2019 Road Rehabilitation

Myrtle Street, Gregory Place, Locust Street

Dear Property Owner/Occupant,

The City of St. Thomas will soon be starting construction on your street. This letter provides details about the project and important information on how construction may impact you.

### Project Details

- Location:** Myrtle Street, Gregory Place, Locust Street
- Schedule:** Tentative start date – week of May 27, 2019  
Estimated time of completion – beginning of July 2019
- Scope:**
- Full depth replacement of asphalt;
  - Spot curb repairs;
  - Catchbasin lid replacement.
- Contractor:** Dufferin Construction

### How will Construction Impact You?

**Traffic:** The roadway will be closed to through traffic during construction, but will remain open to local traffic at all times. Due to the nature of this work, there will be times during the project when driveway access will be limited or restricted for a short period of time. Advance notice of driveway impacts will be provided when possible.

**Parking:** On street parking will be permitted outside of construction work hours. Work hours are anticipated to be 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

**Vibration:** Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

**Garbage/Recycling Collection:** Access for garbage/recycling collection will be maintained when possible. In the event there is a disruption, the contractor will pick up your garbage (where you usually leave it) and move it to a location it can be picked up at. Please mark your municipal address on all containers.

**Safety:** Stay safe and avoid the work area during construction. Maintain a safe distance from construction vehicles entering and leaving the site.
