BY-LAW NO. 35-63

TO LICENSE NON-RESIDENT TRANSIENT PHOTOGRAPHERS IN THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS

AS AMENDED BY:

By-Law No. 65-94

May 2, 1994

WHEREAS Section 400 (4) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, provides for licensing, regulating and governing non-resident transient photographers;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas deems it expedient that a by-law be passed licensing, regulating and governing non-resident transient photographers in the said City;

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.(a) From and after the passing of this by-law, no photographer or other person who for gain uses a photographic camera or other similar device and who is not a resident of the City of St. Thomas, shall go from place to place or to a particular place within the limits of the City of St. Thomas in pursuit of such use or business, notwithstanding that any product is to be delivered in the said municipality afterwards, unless he has a license so to do from the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas.
- 1.(b) No photographer or other persons shall for gain use photographic cameras or other similar devices in or upon any highway or public place unless he has a license to do so from the Corporation. (B/L 65-94)
- 1.(c) No photographer or other person who for gain uses photographic cameras or other similar devices shall be required to obtain a license under subsection 1.(a) and under subsection 1.(b). (B/L 65-94)
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections 1.(a) and 1.(b), this by-law shall not apply to photographers or other persons who take photographs for use in newspapers, magazines or other periodicals or in television broadcasts or to photographers on specific assignment to local industries. (B/L 65-94)
3. Applications for any such license shall be made in writing to the License Administrator of the said City at the City Hall, St. Thomas and shall contain:
 - (1) The full name and residence and business address of the applicant,
 - (2) The name and address of the applicant's employer, if the applicant is not self-employed,
 - (3) The days, times and place or places when and where within the City of St. Thomas he proposes to use for purposes of gain a photographic camera or other similar device
4. The fee for a license required by subsection 1.(a) or for a license required by subsection 1.(b) shall be \$150.00 for any year or part thereof. (B/L 65-94)
5. Licenses issued under the provisions of this by-law shall be and remain in force and effect from the date of issue thereof until the 31st day of December in the year of issue and not thereafter.
6. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offense. (B/L 65-94)
7. This by-law shall take force and become effective from and after the date of the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 3rd date of June, A.D., 1963.

READ a third time and finally passed this 3rd date of June, A.D., 1963.
