### Announcing: Railway City Transit

ST. THOMAS, ON — The City is pleased to announce a new revitalized brand and suite of services for the 150 year old public transit service that is consistent with the past, present and future of the Railway City:



Some of the key new service enhancements will include:

- **Extended Monday to Friday hours** from 5:45pm to 9:45pm.
- **Extended Saturday hours** from 5:45pm to 9:45pm
- **New Sunday service** from 9:15am to 5:45pm
- **Expanded coverage** of the Industrial Area
- **More frequent east/west service** from the west end of Talbot, stopping at the SmartCentres hub, and ending at the Elgin Centre.

In addition to the expanded schedule there will be new stops, shelters, and passenger amenities and the transit hubs at the SmartCentres and Elgin Centre locations will be upgraded with larger shelters and seating areas.

A good transit system is a key measure of a City's quality of life as it provides critical mobility and accessibility for those going to work, school, medical appointments, shopping and more. These enhancements represent an overhaul to the City's system and will be something that will make us even more #stthomasproud.

Over the next few months, the final preparations will be implemented and the new system will be launched in early 2021. Look for the new ride guide coming soon!
