



## St. Thomas Community Improvement Plan Update

The City of St. Thomas is undertaking a review of its 2003 Community Improvement Plan (CIP). The review was initiated by Council to examine the areas of the City to which the CIP applies and the specific programs of the CIP to determine if modifications could be made to improve the effectiveness of the program in using municipal investment to stimulate matching private investment in revitalization efforts. This review follows on an initiative by Council to broaden the CIP Area to include all lands within the City. A copy of the draft amendments will be available on the City's website on October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020.
