

CITY OF ST. THOMAS

BY-LAW NO. 135-76

To prohibit the discharge of
guns or firearms in the City
of St. Thomas.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas has determined to prohibit the discharge of guns or firearms within the City except as otherwise authorized by this By-Law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subject to Section 2 of this by-law, no person shall discharge any gun, or other firearm, airgun or spring gun within the City of St. Thomas.
2. Notwithstanding Section 1 of this by-law:
 - (a) a police officer or constable may discharge any gun or firearm in the City of St. Thomas in performance of his duty.
 - (b) where a danger to public health or safety exists or is apprehended as a result of the presence, congregation, or flocking in a public place of any animal or bird, any animal control officer, the property maintenance supervisor or any other person designated by the Council in writing may discharge any gun or firearm in the performance of his duty.
3. Every person convicted of a breach of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate, a sum not exceeding \$1000.00 for each such offence exclusive of costs.


