- City. Dave McNea mentioned that when the sidewalks slope down for driveways, a sight challenged individual would not be able to see the slope and he himself has fallen.

Catherine Spratley has ordered up a frame for a bench/accessible table and has asked if the Municipal Accessibility Committee would consider contributing monies they received from Council towards this project. Ed to talk to Catherine and request a letter requesting this as well as pictures/drawings for the Committee to vote on for the next meeting in November.
