- 9. The City of St. Thomas shall not assume any liability for any claims of damages, loss of income, or injury of any nature whatsoever arising out of the use of the St. Thomas Municipal Airport for the purpose stated.
- 10. Submission of a \$200. deposit with the Airport Superintendent at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of the event, which will be refunded if the grounds are left in a clean and tidy condition to the satisfaction of the Airport Superintendent.
- 11. That an exchange of future volunteer service affect the fee for the use of the airport.
