TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made by the owners, **DAN MURRAY AND MAUREEN PRIEM**, for a minor variance pursuant to Section 45(1) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, on lands municipally known as **63 ROSEBERY PLACE** in the City of St. Thomas, Ontario:

The subject lands are located within Third Residential Zone (R3) pursuant to the City of St. Thomas Zoning By-Law 50-88, as amended. The applicants, being the owners of the subject lands, have applied for a minor variance from the provisions of Zoning By-Law No. 50-88, as amended. The applicants are requesting the following minor variance:

(i) To permit an accessory building with a floor area of 65.04m², whereas Table 1 to Subsection 7.4, Item Number 6, and Column 2 of the City of St. Thomas Zoning By-Law 50-88 permits an accessory building with a maximum floor area of 40m².

The applicants are requesting the Committee of Adjustment consider a minor variance application to increase the size of the existing garage $(44.6m^2)$ located within the rear yard through the construction of a $3.04m \times 6.70m$ addition $(20.44m^2)$. A minor variance is required to permit a floor area of $65.04m^2$, whereas the Zoning By-law permits a maximum floor area of $40m^2$ for an accessory building.
