Fred - REACT at park at 11am – will direct traffic inside the park to designated parking areas and assist with cars leaving the park at the end of the evening.

Matt - Volunteers with reflective vests - 2 @ park entrance and 1 at Tennis Courts and Parkside Dr. at the end of the night to redirect traffic out of the park.

Bill Todd, Fire - will have keys to Emslie field for gates. Will be locked through the day and opened after the cool down time after fireworks. All traffic exiting through Emslie field onto Parkside Drive South bound only.

End of the evening - Barricades at park entrance (no exit) and Parkside Drive (no northbound turns).

Confirm map with Police for cruisers.

Jeff – Traffic for 2017 suggestion – let out both ways at tennis courts, Police at Parkside and Elm, front of park, Elm and Wilson and Elm and Elmina.
