The Committee discussed the upcoming event:

Mayor – continued issues at Elm St. and Pinafore Entrance

Secretary – will advertise in the paper and on the City website, promoting additional parking at various locations.

Councillor Burgess – make signs for front of Park if parking lot inside is full through the day, indicate Memorial parking lot as alternative. Same as last year

Mayor – continue with additional accessible parking inside the park.

Randy - Park Entrance shut down at 8 pm with no entry. People may still exit until 9pm at which time the park entrance will be completely blocked off until after fireworks.

Fred - REACT at park at 11am – will direct traffic inside the park to designated parking areas and assist with cars leaving the park at the end of the evening.

Kinsmen volunteers with reflective vests - 2 @ park entrance and 1 at Tennis Courts and Parkside Dr. at the end of the night to redirect traffic out of the park.

Bill Todd, Fire – I will have keys to Emslie field for gates. Will be locked through the day and opened after the cool down time after fireworks. All traffic exiting through Emslie field onto Parkside Drive South bound only.

Secretary will send a confirming map to Randy for the Police cruisers.

The Committee discussed Jeff Pallister's recommendations for 2017 – let out both ways at tennis courts, Police at Parkside and Elm, front of park, Elm and Wilson and Elm and Elmina.
